KidCheck Attendant

Do you enjoy making people feel welcome, meeting new people, and can perform basic technology skills? We would make a great addition to our KidCheck team! Curatendants serve one Sunday a month at the beginning of a Courant the services on that Sunday. Responsibilities included belooming families as they arrive, helping new families check in for the first time, and checking guardian tags as parents pick up their children. You are still able to attend the Worship Service and an ABF on your assigned Sunday. We just ask that you are available to greet families 15 minutes before each service begins.

Nursery Care

You provide love and care for our youngest Mountain Movers and their parents. Babies begin to learn the meaning of trust as they interact with those in the nursery, and we reassure parents that their little ones are well cared for as they attend their own classes. Volunteers in the nursery are scheduled for one service twice a month, every other month. We currently have opportunities in the 8:15 and 10:45 services.

8:15 Service

Adventure Children's Church Teacher

When children in grades 1-4 get dismissed from the service, you will have about 30 minutes to review the previous week's lesson with them in the form of sharing the Bible form (a video is available if needed) along with engaging attrities. A lesson plan is provided, but there is also an opportunity for you to use your own creativity as you plan your lesson. This tends to be a smaller group of kids (typically 5-10 of them) and it's a great opportunity to get to know them well in a fairly laid-back environment. We currently have openings to serve once or twice a month from September through May. This age group attends the worship service with their families over the summer and on major holiday weekends.

10:45 Service

Adventure 12 Children's Church Teacher (Grades 1 & 2)

When children in grades 1-4 get dismissed from the service, you will have about 30 minutes to review and build upon the lesson from that morning by sharing the Bible Story (a video is available if needed) and providing engaging activities. A lesson plan is provided, but there is also an opportunity for you to use your own creativity as you plan your lesson. You can expect to have about 10-15 kids in your class and by this time of the morning they do best with activities that incorporate movement and still tie into the lesson. We currently have openings to serve once a month from September through May. This group attends the worship service with their families over the summer and on major holiday weekends.

Discovery Children's Church Teacher (2 & 3 year-olds)

If you are a caring individual who understands the needs and abundant blessings that come along with serving this age group, we'd love for you to consider serving! These children are discovering what it means to have some structure added to their time at church within a loving environment, and although beneficial playtime encompasses most of their time in class, you will provide a short Bible story (through telling or the available video) and an age-appropriate activity for the children. We do provide lesson plans and extra resources, but you can use your own creativity or decide what works best for your class. Please note that this age group may still require diaper changes and help with using the potty, so you'll need to be comfortable with those situations. We currently have the opportunity to serve once or twice a month.

Discovery Children's Church Assistant (2 & 3 year-olds)

This is an opportunity to show love to and connect with the children in this class. Your role requires welcoming the children into your classroom as well as assisting the teacher throughout your time together. Please note that this age group may still require diaper changes and help with using the potty, so you'll need to be comfortable with those situations.

Wednesday Night Clubs

Discovery PreK & K Teacher

These older preschoolers and Kindergartners come with lots of energy and can't wait to take part in an evening with songs, an engaging Bible story, and fun activities that reinforce the lesson. A lesson plan with ample activity ideas will be provided, and you can pick and choose what works best for you and your class. The kids begin arriving at 6:45 p.m. and will get picked up between 8:00 – 8:15. Our Wednesday Night Discovery volunteers serve one month at a time, and you would be expected to serve the months of October, February, and April.

Discovery Assistant (2's & 3's or PreK & K)

This is an opportunity to show love to and cornect with the children in these classes, along with their families. Four role requires welcoming the children into you has as well as assisting the teacher throughout the events. The kids begin arriving at 6:45 p.m. and will get picked pretween 8:00 – 8:15. Our Wednesday Night Discovery volunteers serve one month at a time, and you would be expected to serve the months of October, February, and April.

Other things to note...

As you are considering where you can serve, know that all teachers are provided with an assistant. There is some prep work expected during the week before you teach, and the amount depends on the age you teach and how much you choose to put into it. If you need supplies for a lesson they will either be provided for you, or you can be reimbursed if you need to purchase something.

Also, we understand that there may be times you are unable to serve on your given Sunday due to vacation or illness. You can try to switch with another person on the schedule or we will help you to find a sub if needed.

In order to serve families well, we ask that you arrive 15 minutes ahead of the service in which you're serving in order to relieve the volunteers from the previous hour as well as welcome the children who are just arriving.
